Abstracts are being solicited for posters to be displayed in the main meeting hall during the 2016 New Hampshire Oral Health Forum. The posters will be available for all attendees to view throughout the entire program. <u>Previously presented posters are welcome</u>.

Conference topics include:

- Emerging multidisciplinary roles in oral health and dentistry.
- Emerging trends in preventative and restorative dental services.
- Changes in NH Medicaid oral health and dental policies.
- Communication and referral between medical and dental providers.
- Critical access to dental care in a changing health care environment.
- Oral Health during Pregnancy
- The multiple roles and opportunities for the public health oral health practitioner in non-traditional settings.
- Pharmacist's role in oral health.
- Topics on the oral-systemic health link.
- The role of primary care in the delivery of and referral to oral health care services for children and adults.

### **Potential Presentation Areas**

Possible topics include issues related to partnerships to improve oral health, special populations, caries risk assessment and management, access to care, medical/dental integration, community-based clinics, non-traditional dental settings, community successes, tobacco, oral health in pregnancy issues, nutrition, fluoride, sealants, oral health and addiction, oral health education and any topic related to the Forum.

Submission of an abstract or descriptive outline of 200-300 words or less and two learning objectives should be submitted for consideration.
