



17th Congress (2021-2022) Legislation Relevant to Oral Health

S. 97/H.R. 502 To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide for coverage of dental services under the Medicare program.

The term 'dental and oral health services' 15 means services (as defined by the Secretary) that are necessary to prevent disease and promote oral health, restore oral structures to health and function, and treat emergency conditions, including:

1. routine diagnostic and preventive care such as dental cleanings, exams, and x-rays;
2. basic dental services such as fillings and extractions;
3. major dental services such as root canals, crowns, and dentures;
4. emergency dental care; and other necessary services related to dental and oral health (as defined by the Secretary).

Payment

- For the first year beginning at least 6 months after the date of the enactment 0%;
- For the year following the first year and each subsequent year through the seventh the applicable percent specified will increased by 10 percentage points; and
- for the eighth year following the year and each subsequent year, 80 %.

H.R. 914 — Dental Care for Veterans Act

To amend title 38, United States Code, to require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to furnish dental care in the same manner as any other medical service, and for other purposes. This bill expands eligibility for veterans for dental care provided by the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA). Specifically, the bill makes all veterans who are enrolled in the VA health care system eligible for VA-provided dental services. Currently, only veterans who have a service-connected dental issue or meet other narrow criteria are eligible for certain dental services.

S.560 - A bill to improve coverage of maternal oral health care, and for other purposes

To amend MEDICAID.—Section 1905 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396d) requiring coverage of oral health services for pregnant and postpartum individuals

This bill would make Medicaid dental benefits mandatory for pregnant and post-partum 60 days at 100% FMAP. Aligns CHIP allotment, make oral health part of pregnancy/postpartum essential health benefits, and includes grants to FQHCs to contract with private dentists.

Step in percentage of payments over 3 years with accommodation for low-income seniors of 80%-100% in 2023 (percentage dependent upon type of service.

- 2023 – 30%
- 2024 – 60%
- 2025 – 80%

The benefit will cover:

Preventative and screening services, such as oral exams, dental cleanings, dental x-rays, and fluoride treatments;

- Basic dental services, such as tooth restorations, basic periodontics services, tooth extractions, and oral disease management services;

- Major dental services, such as major tooth restorations, major periodontics services, bridges, crowns, root canals, and extractions;
- Emergency dental care; and
- Other necessary services related to dental or oral health (as defined by the Secretary).
- Partial or full dentures one upper or lower replacement every 5 years.
